## FROM YOUR SOCIAL JUSTICE TEAM

It should be no surprise that "Affordable Housing" is a major social concern in the Naples community. The latest "Point in Time Study" conducted by the The Hunger and Homeless Coalition of Collier County in 2018 revealed that there were more than 1,000 homeless kids in Collier County, a sizable increase from the previous year precipitated largely by Hurricane Irma. Further complicating the homeless picture is an increasing elderly population at risk of homelessness because their incomes can't keep up with their housing costs. Creating the awareness of this problem continues to be a major concern of the Social Justice Ministry team. 
