It should be no surprise that "Affordable Housing" is a major social concern in the Naples community. The latest "Point in Time Study" conducted by the The Hunger and Homeless Coalition of Collier County in 2018 revealed that there were more than 1,000 homeless kids in Collier County, a sizable increase from the previous year precipitated largely by Hurricane Irma. Further complicating the homeless picture is an increasing elderly population at risk of homelessness because their incomes can't keep up with their housing costs. Creating the awareness of this problem continues to be a major concern of the Social Justice Ministry team. If this issue is of interest to you, join us for a presentation and interactive discussion with Ashley Jones, a representative from the Salvation Army, who has considerable experience working with the homeless in Collier County. This event will take place on **Tuesday May 14th at 5:30 pm** in the Conference Room.

WEEKEND POWER PACK

Please help the Weekend Power Pack Team on **Wednesday, May 15, 10:00am-11:00am in Fellowship Hall**. We will be packing 400 bags of food for homeless children. We need volunteers very much! According to data gathered in April, 2018 by the Hunger & Homeless Coalition of Collier County, there are 1,215 homeless school age children enrolled in Collier County Public Schools. These children live in emergency and transitional shelters, in cars, the woods, or temporarily in other people's homes. When VPC became aware of this situation nine years ago the Weekend Power Pack Program (WPP) was created. Throughout the school year on week days, breakfast and lunch are provided by the schools to children of low income families, there is nothing for them on weekends. September through May WPP volunteers purchase and bag nonperishable food, for Saturday and Sunday for 40-50 homeless school children. The Power Packs contain two breakfasts, two lunches, two dinners and four snacks and are placed in the children's backpacks by the Guidance Counselor before they leave school on Friday. The program is funded entirely by donations from church members and friends of our congregation. The cost is approximately \$140.00 per child yearly, or \$7,000 a year. Imagine being a homeless, hungry, child. Please help the Power Pack Team on Wednesday, May 15 at 10:00am in Fellowship Hall assemble the power packs for the children! Summer Camp for Collier's Needy Children

There are more than 1,200 homeless children in Collier County, 34% more homeless since hurricane Irma. The Salvation Army is targeting homeless children with a week of summer camp. These children come from migrant farmer families, low income families, and children that don't sleep in the same bed each night. Staff at Camp Keystone are trained to reach out to these children with experiences that will help them grow and learn while striving to meet their spiritual, social, and educational needs. A week of summer camp generates many profound and positive learning experiences that will be a lifetime remembrance. A donation of \$250 will sponsor a 7 to 12-year-old to a week of camp. This is an investment in a child that is "at risk" to trafficking and continuous poverty. Please consider sponsoring more than one child. Little Known About Naples Salvation Army

A little known and often surprising fact about Collier County is that approximately 60 percent of children in the public-school system live at or below the poverty level. The Salvation Army of Collier County has partnered with the Collier County Public Schools, Hunger and Homeless Coalition of Collier County, and Youth Haven SWFL to identify Naples children with the most need and the most at risk. Our Fran Cohen Youth Center after-school and summer camp programs were designed to offer families affordable childcare. 156 children are currently enrolled and weekly tuition is 33-50% cheaper than other after-school programs in the area. Right now, 44 children receive discounted tuition averaging \$700 a week in scholarships. We would not be able to offer these rates if not for your generous support and volunteer hours.



We use responsive or unison readings and prayers at different times. The leader will read the words in italics. The congregation reads the words in bold print. All baptized Christians are welcome to receive Communion with us. Between services, we have a time for refreshments and fellowship: we gather in our **Fellowship Hall** (east end of our building,) or in the **Youth Center** (west end of our building) where families with young children enjoy time together, immediately following the conclusion of the 9:30 a.m. service. Please come and join us, as we would love to get to know you better. We hope you are interested in becoming a member or affiliate member of this church.
